SUBJECT : 2026 Annual Work Plan for the Florence and Sinclair-Bruneau Mining Properties

As part of its 2026 exploration program, Fresnillo Canada (Fresnillo) will soon carry out work on its Florence and Sinclair-Bruneau mining properties. These mining properties are located in the Eeyou Istchee James Bay territory, approximately 90 km southwest of the Cree community of Waswanipi and approximately 40 km northwest of the municipality of Lebel-sur-Quévillon.

The objective of this exploration program is to obtain additional information on the bedrock properties. The work planned for 2026 consists of conducting an airborne geophysical survey (gravimetry). This airborne geophysical survey will be carried out only during daytime using an aircraft or helicopter flying at low altitude. No groundwork will be undertaken.

Map 1 below shows the location of the planned work on the Florence and Sinclair-Bruneau mining properties.

The proposed work is expected to take place between October and December 2026, outside the moose hunting season.

All permits and authorizations required for the work, where applicable, will be obtained before the start of activities.

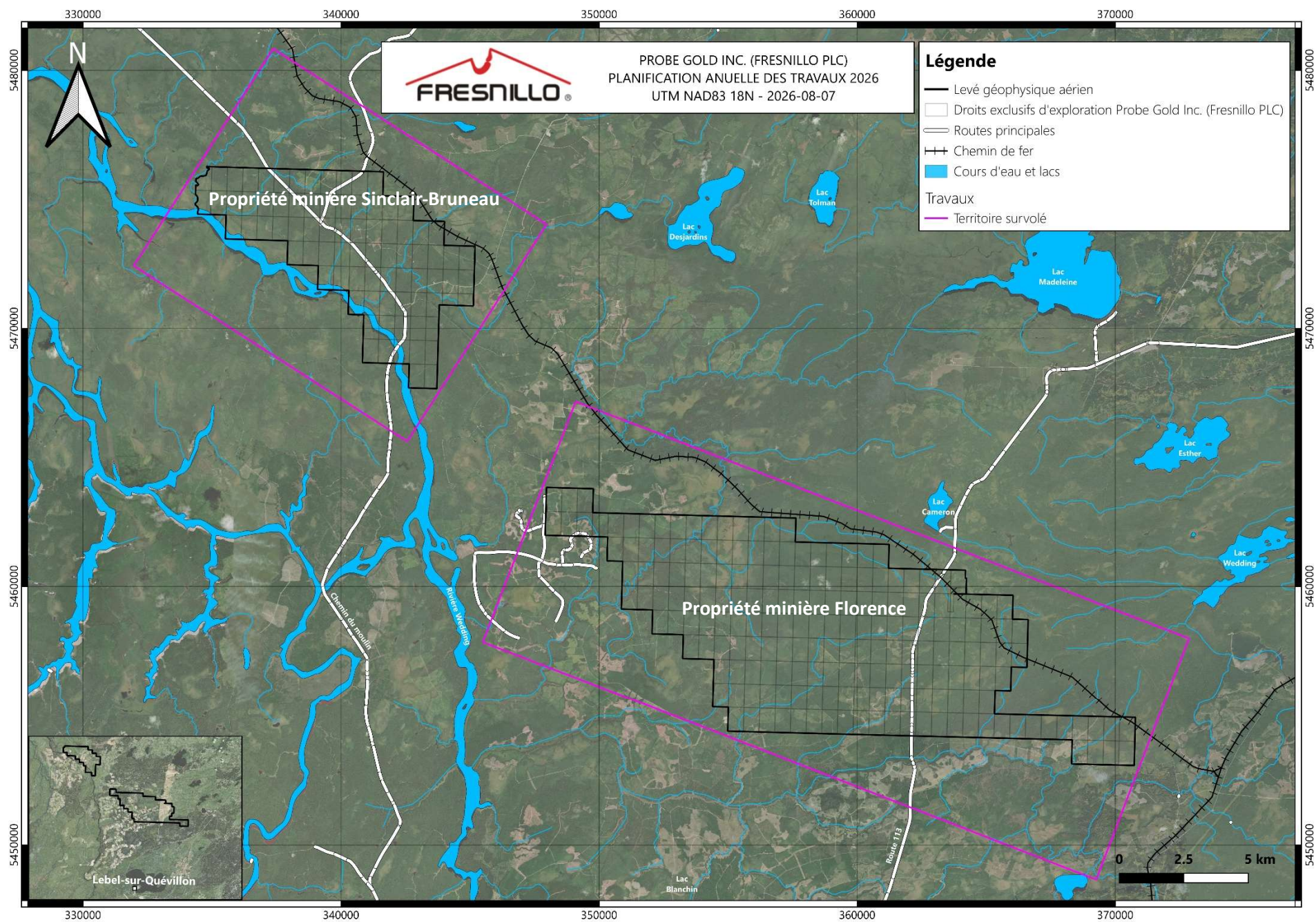
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Map 1 : Location of Work on the Florence and Sinclair-Bruneau Mining Properties - 2026
